
## Notepad

A floating Notepad allows a student to take notes within a document, use as a scratchpad for math problems, collect information from multiple pages or even use to type out a rough draft response depending on the functionality of the notepad. An example of using a notepad is shown here. Notepad is a free program that comes with most versions of Windows on PC's.

Shown here, in windows 7 I have opened MS Word then launched Notepad. I can re-size the notepad window and move it around on the screen to place where I want it. Notepad will float on top of the Word document allowing me to type text inside it until I click to place my cursor inside the Word document.

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The Notepad is then minimized. I can click on the Notepad icon in the task bar to bring it back up - to again float on top of the Word document.



## Notepad programs for computers

- Notepad (included as a program in Windows on PC's)
- Kurzweil 3000 - ability to add pop up bubble notes anywhere in a locked document
- Adobe Reader - can add pop up notes in documents

## Android (from the Google Play Store)

- Floating Stickies - sticky notes float on top of the screen
- Hovernote - notepad that hovers on top of open apps
- Floating Notes 2 for Android
