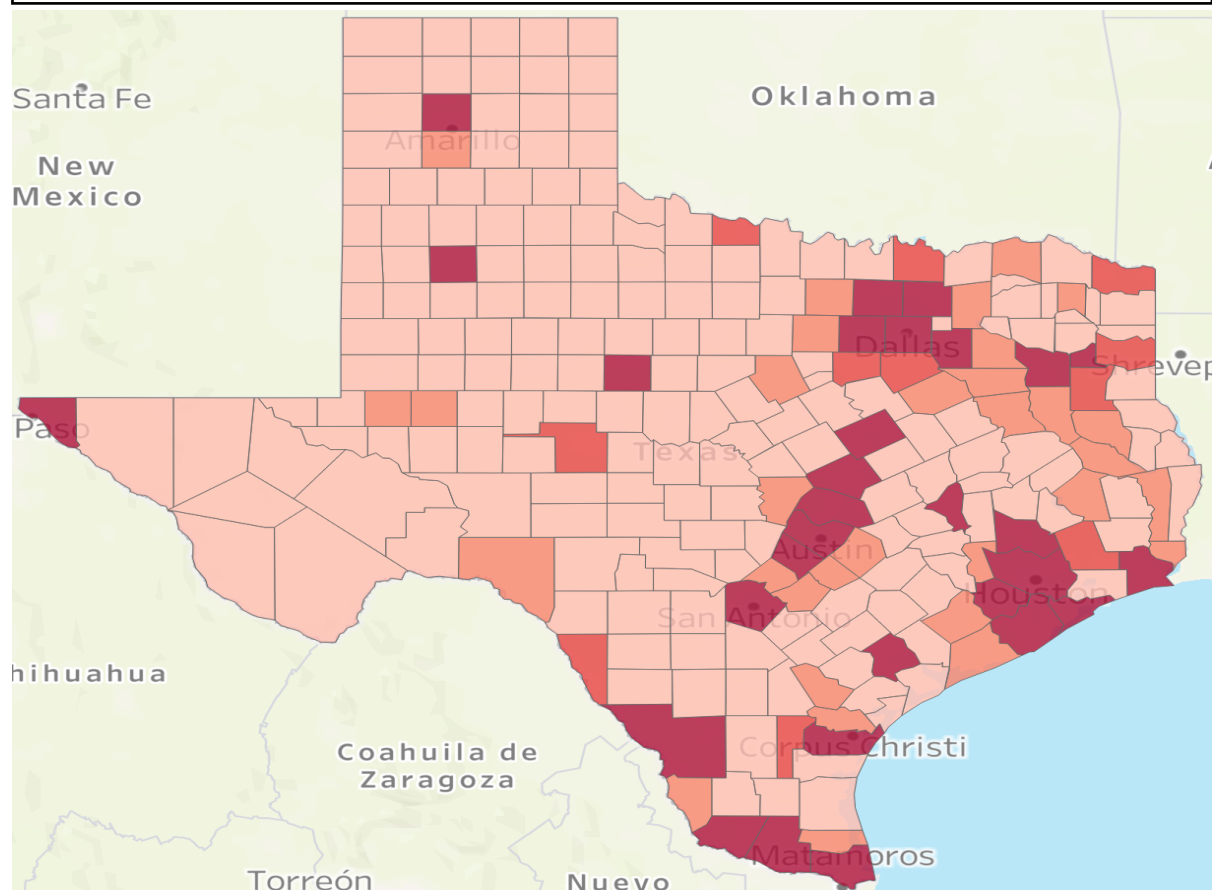
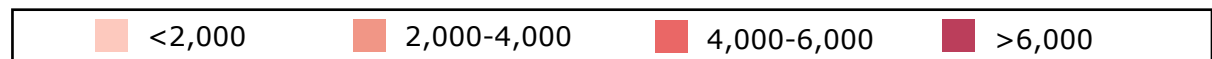


# Lack of Broadband Subscription Ranking by Number of Households
