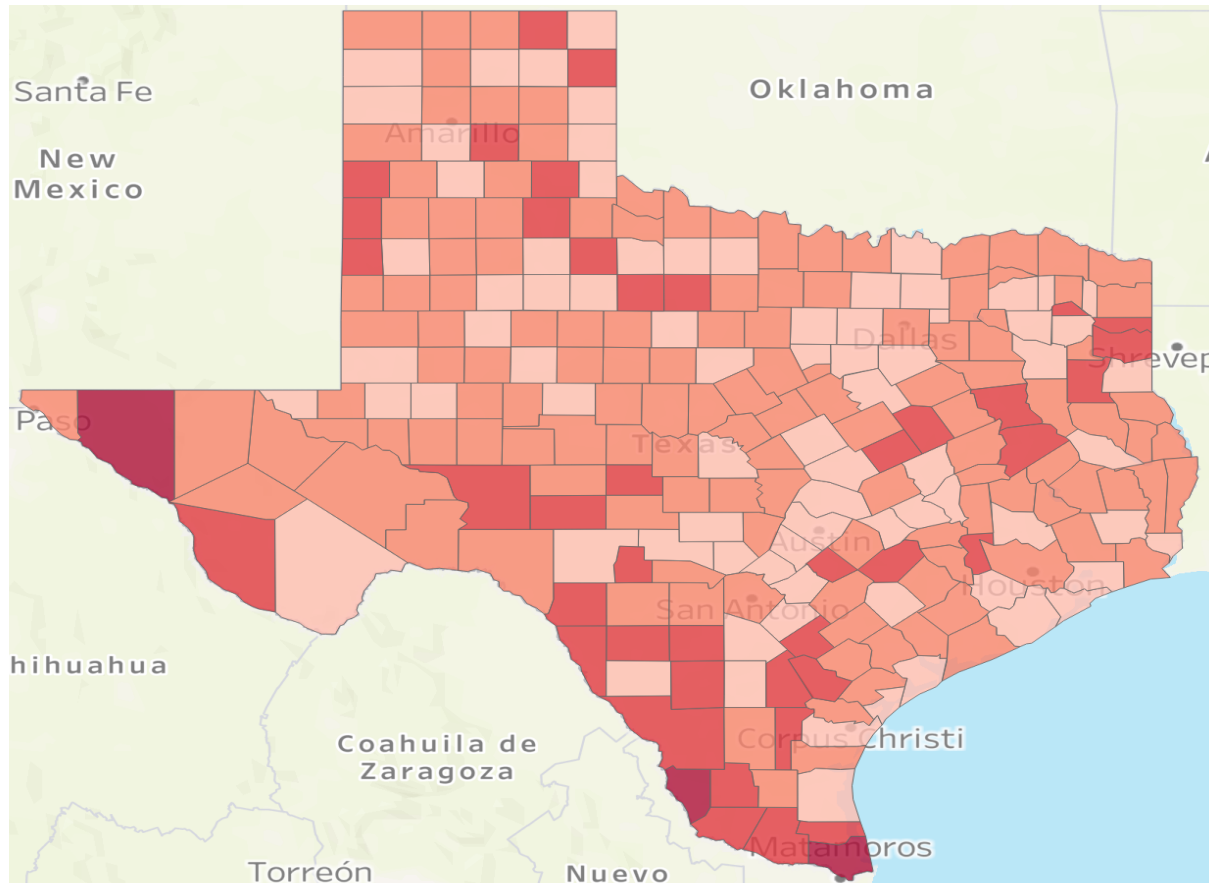


# Broadband Subscription Ranking by Percent of Households
