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CACFP Creditable Infant Foods

Participants will review the infant meal pattern and discuss creditable foods for each required component as well as use the resources and tools available to determine if foods are creditable or not creditable in the CACFP for Infants.

08/26 - 10:30

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CACFP Administrative Responsibilities

Participants will review the requirements for continued program eligibility, identify supporting documentation for Viability, Capability, and Accountability (VCA), as well as review and evaluate the requirements for Financial Management, Monitoring, Training, Procurement, and Filing Claims.

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CACFP Enrollment & Eligibility

Participants will review and identify the required elements of participant eligibility and enrollment documentation.

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CACFP Meal Patterns and Creditable Foods

Participants will review and identify components of the Meal Patterns for Children and Adults, how to credit foods, and how to implement meal modifications for special dietary needs in order to serve reimbursable meals. In addition, participants will review best practices while menu planning and build a reimbursable meal.

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CACFP Prevent Serious Deficiencies with Effective Policies and Procedures and Corrective Action Documents

Participants will review the steps in the Serious Deficiency Process including the function of the National Disqualified List (NDL) as well as review and identify the key elements in written Policies and Procedures and Corrective Action Documents that will prevent serious deficiencies from occurring.

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CACFP Meal Service: Time, Methods, & Documentation

Participants will review best practices for the timing of meal service as well as identify the key elements of different meal service types and the requirements of each. In addition, participants will review and practice required meal documentation including the required elements of a Meal Production Record.
