



## Holocaust 101: Teaching About the Holocaust

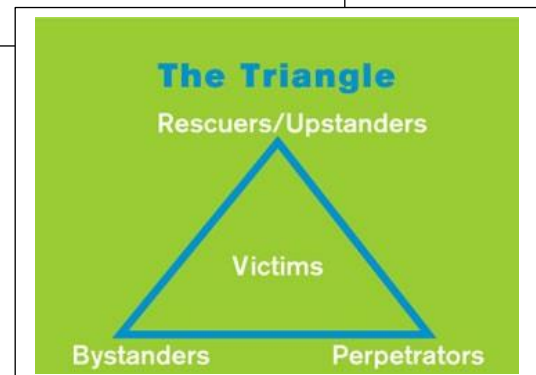
**Saturday, October 21, 2017**
