Requested Non-Member LEA or Charter Schools Services and Applicable Fees

This fee schedule shall be determined by the RDSPD SSA. Fees are subject to change at the discretion of the RDSPD SSA. Services are contingent upon staff availability.

Region 4 RDSPD is guaranteed one hour of travel, billed at a rate of \$30 per hour, on any day the following services are rendered. Travel time will be negotiated if one hour is insufficient for the delivery of services.

Non-member LEA or charter schools will be invoiced monthly for all services rendered for the previous month.

EVALUATION

If an evaluation is requested, a consultation will be conducted to determine if any special factors will need to be taken into consideration. Special factors could include but are not limited to additional suspected eligibilities under IDEA-B, languages other than English, or additional instructional and/or related services. In these circumstances, additional charges may be incurred.

ITINERANT SERVICES

Itinerant Teacher of the Deaf

Fee: \$60 per hour per person for the following services:

- a. Observation
- b. Equipment in-services
- c. Deliver batteries with consultation
- d. Troubleshoot hearing aids/equipment
- e. Shuttle/dispense broken and repaired aids
- f. Consult with teachers on accommodations or modifications
- g. Consult with diagnosticians on procedures and paperwork related to AI eligibility
- h. ARD participation
- i. Direct and/or consultative services to students

Speech and Language Pathologist / Assistant

Fee: \$100 per hour for the following services:

- a. Direct and/or consultative speech and language services

Social Worker

- a. Student counseling
- b. Parent education

Fee: \$100 per hour for the following services:

Audiologist

- a. Dispense audiological equipment
- b. Staff training

Fee: \$100 per hour for the following services:

Interpreter

- a. Cluster site interpreting services

Fee: \$60 per hour for the following services:

AUDIOLOGICAL EQUIPMENT

There will be a fee of \$350 annually for the rental of audiological equipment.

Disclaimers

This Agreement does not contemplate the provision of interpreter services, as an itinerant service or for any non-instructional program or any extracurricular activity.

Students who attend a centralized program/cluster site will not be considered a transfer student.

Non-member school districts and charter schools receiving Consulting Services, as well as any Member District electing to receive Consulting Services, will be billed according to this fee schedule. A per-pupil tuition fee will be charged for students receiving direct services as set forth in Paragraph 7.2 of the Agreement.
